Experience Breisach am Rhein in 48 hours. 48 hours is enough time to get to know the most beautiful sides of Breisach, as well as its other parts. Here is what you should do and experience in Breisach in 2 days!

Let's Begin Your 2- Day Stay.

If you have not checked into your hotel or other accommodation yet, make sure to do that first to drop your luggage off. Now that you have correctly arrived in Breisach, we can begin! If you are still searching for a night- time accommodation, our team at the Breisach-Touristik, located on the Marktplatz, will happily assist you in finding a suitable accommodation. Grab a city plan and an informational brochure and onward we go.



As the right entry into your short trip, we recommend a visit to the Breisacher Cafés or Eisdielen, on the **Marktplatz**, or any one that is near the Marktplatz.



Invigorated, you are on the way to explore the Breisach Cathedral. You will receive the city plan with explanations in our office. Follow the red tour, the **Church- Hill Tour (Münsterbergtour).** This leads up to our emblem, the St. Stephans Church. Along the way, you will come across interesting informational boards, as well as discover many of Breisach's places of interest. Experience more about Breisach's past and let yourself be surprised from the historical places and buildings you'll find along the way.

If you come to the Rheintorplatz, go into the Rheintor and visit our **Museum For City History** (**Museum für Stadtgeschichte**). In the museum, you'll find some 400 m² testomonials from the Stone Age to the present. The museum is open the following hours: Tuesday to Friday 14-17 o'clock, Saturday/ Sunday/ Holidays 11.30-17 o'clock. Let yourself take a fun travel through time. End your Münsterberg-Tour with a visit to the **Rheinufers**. There, you can take a beautiful stroll along the river bank. In between, make yourself comfortable along the bank and watch the swans and the big and small ships that pass by. Refreshments in between are offered in the Breisacher Weinbrunnen by the shipping piers.

Then follow the blue route and the loop "Lyrik am Wege". This tour brings you up to the Eckartsberg. From this viewpoint, you have an amazing view of Breisach, the Rhine and the surrounding area, even up to the Vogesen and the Black Forest. Subsequently, this tour leads you through Breisach's shopping street. Take your time and visit the shops. The "Neutorstraße", "Richard Müller-Straße", "Rheinstraße", "Kupfertorstraße", the

"Neutorplatz" and the "Marktplatz" offer you an attractive shopping experience.

In between or at the end of your lower city tour, you can settle and treat yourself to **a mid-day snack** in the Cafés on the Marktplatz or in a gastronomy restaurant in the Neutorstraße. From simple Badisch cuisine to foreign specialties, there is something for everyone!



With a joyful feeling of fullness, you then set off on the way to the **Geldermann Private Winery (Geldermann Privatsektkelleri)** or in the **Badonian Winery (Badischen Winzerkeller)** and take a **tour** through the undergrounds.

At 14.00 from Monday to Sunday, the Sektkellerei Geldermann offers 1-hour daily guided tours included with a sparkling wine tasting (no registration required). Outside of these hours, there are still tours available upon request at www.geldermann.de (Tel.



07667/834-258) In the Badisch Winery, you can find guided tours every Tuesday, Thursday and Sunday at 14.30, also included with a wine tasting (no registration required). If you spend a weekend here in Breisach anywhere from the middle of June to the beginning of September, you have the possibility to visit at local performance in our **Festspiele**. The performances are Saturday and Sunday from 15.00 to 20.00 o'clock respectively. The performances can be found on the open air theater above on the Münsterberg. There are many destinations that you can visit from Breisach in half a day. You have the possibility of taking a side trip to the french side (which is right across from Breisach), to our partner city, Neuf-Brisach, (5 km away), or in Colmar (23 km away). Neuf-Brisach is a fortress city built by Vauban and has been part of World Culteral Heritage UNESCO since 2008. From Breisach, you can take bus number 1076 to Neuf-Brisach, which also takes you up to Colmar. You can receive schedule times and further information to Neuf-Brisach and Colmar from us here at

Breisach- Touristik.

Another destination would be Freiburg, with its charming old city center. You can get there comfortably with the Breisgau S-Bahn. Take the Schlossbergbahn up to the Freiburg Schlossberg or indulge in a "Lange Rote" on the Freiburg church market. A visit to the Freiburg Münster is worth it and should definitely be undertaken. Here at Breisach-Touristik, we have further information about time schedules and city plans at your disposal. We can also happily arrange a city tour for you in Freiburg.



The Badisch vineyards **Kaiserstuhl** and **Tuniberg** are not to be forgotten. Breisach lies between these two. In addition to excellent wines, the region offers a large network of cycling, biking, and hiking trails. Flyers and
